George Schmidt is a native New Orleanian and received his Master of Fine Arts from Tulane University. He is celebrating more than 35 years of living and working on Julia Street in the American Sector, having opened his gallery in 1997. He invites you to take a tour of his neighborhood which contains, besides his gallery at 626 Julia Street, a large collection of his paintings: the Intercontinental Hotel/ Pete's Pub, a series of paintings illustrating the history of the New Orleans Carnival, Jelly Roll Suites and Generations Hall, the studies and finished work of his series of paintings of a history of Jazz music in New Orleans (which he exhibited in a one man show at the New Orleans Museum of Art) and the Hilton Hotel, a painting depicting Louis Armstrong playing with the Fate Marable Band on the S.S. Capitol in 1919 executed as Artist -in- Residence at the Louisiana World's Fair in 1984.
